This is a petition filed under Section 438 Cr. P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case Complaint No. 0111, dated 01.09.2011 titled as Parkash Kumar Jha Vs. Murli Jha, registered under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, vide which the petitioner has been declared proclaimed offender.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has placed on record the copy of the order dated 15.01.2018 of the trial Court to show that in compliance of the order dated 08.01.2018, the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court on 15.01.2018. As per order dated 15.01.2018, passed by the trial Court, he has deposited the costs of Rs.25,000/- with the District Legal Services Authority, Gurugram and has been released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 08.01.2018, passed by this Court is made absolute.
