The petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.221 dated 17.6.2018 registered at Police Station Model Town, District Rewari under Sections 120-B, 186, 279, 332, 336, 353, 420, 467, 458 and 471 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is the driver of a truck from which liquor was recovered as the same was being transported without valid permit. The petitioner has been in custody since 17.6.2018. He is not an accused in any other similar or any other criminal case at all and since the challan has already been presented in the present case, his further custody is not warranted.

Learned State counsel is unable to controvert the factual submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and it is directed that the petitioner be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned.
