Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 not to harass and humiliate the petitioners, as sons of petitioner No.1 and husband of petitioner No.2 are involved in some FIRs.

Reply by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Rohtak has already been filed and as per this reply, sons of petitioner No.1 namely Pawan and Satish were arrested and the police visited the houses of the petitioners in order to arrest the aforesaid two persons, as they are wanted in number of criminal cases/FIRs, as detailed in the affidavit.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that since there are no allegation against the petitioners, who are household ladies, the police has visited their houses without issuance of any notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Budh Singh, has

submitted that the petitioners are not required in any other case and in case, in future, they are required for the purpose of investigation in any case, the police will issue a notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C. and proceed further, accordingly.

In view of the above, this petition is disposed of.
