The petitioners are seeking quashing of FIR No. 200, dated 31.10.2014, under Sections 332, 353, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Sector-14, Panchkula, District Panchkula (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2), which has been arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the FIR is an outcome of a misunderstanding between the parties, which has now been resolved and the matter has been compromised.

Vide order dated 30.09.2016, a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate for recording their statements with regard to veracity of the compromise.

Report of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Panchkula dated 15.10.2016 has been

received, wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, statements of the parties were recorded. As per the statements, compromise is voluntary and without any pressure or coercion.

The FIR is stated to be an outcome of a misunderstanding between the parties, which has been resolved and the matter has been compromised.

In view of the law laid down in “*Narinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab*” 2014 (6) SCC 466, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No. 200, dated 31.10.2014, under Sections 332, 353, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Sector-14, Panchkula, District Panchkula (Annexure P-1) and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioners only.
