The petitioner seeks the concession of bail pending trial in FIR No.559 dated 31.08.2016 under Sections 304-B, 323, 34 IPC along with alternative charge under Section 302/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Assandh, District Karnal.

Learned counsel for the State on instructions from ASI Raj Kumar submits that the trial is at fag end. Only three of the prosecution witnesses remain to be examined. The matter it is submitted is fixed before the learned trial Court for 24.01.2018 and all the three prosecution witnesses shall be examined on 24.01.2018.

Keeping in view the stage of trial, I do not find any ground for affording the concession of bail to the petitioner at this stage.
