This is a petition under section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.81, dated 20.08.2017, under sections 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC (sections 325, 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Sekhwan, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur.

2. Pursuant to the order dated 15.09.2017, report dated 15.12.2017 of J.M.IC., Batala, has been received. According to the said report, the statements of the parties have been recorded and the compromise is genuine and has been reached between the parties voluntarily out of their own free will and without any threat or coercion.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and FIR No.81, dated 20.08.2017, under sections 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC (sections 325, 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Sekhwan, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur, alongwith all consequent proceedings having arisen therefrom, is hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
