The petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.144 dated 09.07.2018, registered at Police Station Bilaspur, District Yamuna Nagar, under Sections 186, 332, 353, 323, 307 427 IPC and Section 13(2) of the Haryana Gauvansh Sanrakshan and Gausamvardhan Act, 2015.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been in custody since 09.07.2018. The investigation is complete as the challan has been presented. However, examination of prosecution witnesses has not yet started. The petitioner does not have any criminal antecedents and thus, he may be released on regular bail.

Learned State counsel does not dispute the aforementioned factual submissions.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner does not have any criminal antecedents and that the trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date, I deem it appropriate to allow this petition. Accordingly, the petition is allowed and petitioner-Gurvinder Singh, is ordered to be

released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned.
