Petitioners Sarabjit Kaur and Kulwinder Singh, who are facing trial under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 before learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Amritsar, have approached this Court impugning the order dated 12.04.2016 (Annexure P-3) passed by the trial Court, whereby the application moved by the petitioners seeking permission to examine handwriting and fingerprint expert for comparing the signatures of petitioner-accused Sarabjit Kaur on the cheque in question with her standard signatures appearing on Vakalatnama, bail bonds and other record of complainant bank, was dismissed.

At this stage, Mr. Prem Singh Nagra, Advocate for Mr. B.P.S. Dhaliwal, Advocate has produced a photocopy of the communication dated

22.08.2018 issued by the Punjab & Sind Bank, branch office, Hall Bazar, Amritsar. The same is taken on record. On the basis of said communication, he states that the petitioners have deposited an amount of Rs.4,15,000/- on 22.08.2018 for full and final adjustment of account. The respondent-bank will issue No Objection Certificate and title deed within next month.

He further states that since the respondent-bank has received the outstanding amount, the bank would move an appropriate application for withdrawal of the complaint before the trial Court within a period of one month from today.

In view of the statement so made by learned counsel for the respondent-bank, learned counsel for the petitioners does not press this petition and wishes to withdraw the same.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
