The petitioner seeks issuance of directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect his life and liberty from respondents No. 5 to 8, who are allegedly threatening him.

The allegations are that he had purchased a new motorcycle and the private respondents snatched the same and also took a sum of Rs. 50,000/- from him. He has made number of representations to various police officials but no action has been taken thereupon and infact the private respondents are threatening him to withdraw his representations.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 4 only.

Mr. Kirat Singh Sidhu, DAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 4. Let five copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

Considering the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to issue notices to respondents No. 5 to 8.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No. 3 to objectively consider the representation dated 18.11.2017 (Annexure P-1) and

to take appropriate action thereupon in accordance with law, in case it is so felt necessary, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
