Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.93 dated 06.07.2018 under Sections 323/324/341/34 IPC and Section 326 IPC (added later on) registered at Police Station Balachaur, District Saheed Bhagat Singh Nagar (Nawanshahr).

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 20.08.2018 of this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Manjit Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact.

At this stage, Mr. Krishan Sehajpal, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant and filed his power of attorney in Court, which is taken on record. He submits that the petitioner has caused grievous injury to the complainant and therefore, he does not deserve the concession of anticipatory bail.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation and no recovery is to be effected from him, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 20.08.2018 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when directed by the investigating agency and shall abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
