In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for anticipatory bail in case FIR No.72 dated 14.07.2018 under Sections 61/78/1/14 of the Excise Act, registered at Police Station Kotbhai, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Learned counsel for the State filed short reply by way of affidavit of Sh. Gurtej Singh Sandhu, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police Sub Division Giddarbaha on behalf of the respondent-State. Same is taken on record. Perusal of para 2 to 5 of the affidavit, it is evident that petitioner is involved in number of criminal proceedings even though he has been acquitted in 2 FIRs the other 3 cases are pending consideration. It seems that petitioner is a habitual offender. Therefore, he is not entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Accordingly, petition stands dismissed.
