SUDIP AHLUWALIA J. (ORAL)

In this petition, the petitioner, who is the accused in F.I.R No.11, dated 02.02.2010, under Sections 458, 326, 323, 324, 325 & 148 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Noormahal, District Jalandhar (Annexure P-1), has prayed for quashing of F.I.R. with all subsequent proceedings, on the basis of compromise.

[2]. Ld. Counsel for the parties submit that the matter has been amicably settled between the rival parties and they would have no objection as regards the FIR in question being quashed.

[3]. It may be mentioned that proceedings arising out of the same FIR qua the remaining five accused persons have already been quashed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in *CRA-S-925-SB-2016* vide its detailed order passed on 26.05.2017, after the report regarding compromise had been

called for from the Ld. Court below. The petitioner happens to be the 6th accused in the concerned FIR with whom admittedly as submitted by Ld. Counsel for respondent No.2/complainant, compromise on the same terms has already been arrived at.

[4]. In the circumstances, the present petition is allowed. F.I.R No.11, dated 02.02.2010, under Sections 458, 326, 323, 324, 325 & 148 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Noormahal, District Jalandhar (Annexure P-1), and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the present petitioner.
