Though in the present petition filed by the petitioners under Section 482 Cr.P.C., multiple prayers have been made, but learned counsel for the petitioners states that at this stage, the petitioners confine their prayer to the extent of protection of their life and liberty only and would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga to consider the representation dated 07.05.2018 (Annexure P-4) made by the petitioners regarding protection of their life and liberty only at the hands of private respondent No.4.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Surinder Pal Singh Tinna, Addl. A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, but considering the fact that the petitioners have confined their prayer qua protection of their life and liberty only, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the contents of representation (Annexure P-4) qua protection of life and liberty of the petitioners only at the hands of private respondent No.4 and to act in accordance with law.
