The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.143 dated 03.07.2018, registered under Sections 406, 420, 465, 467, 468, 506, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC') at Police Station City Faridkot, District Faridkot.

The allegation against the petitioner is that he in connivance with Angrej Singh @ Sonu has misused the cheque of complainant Kaur Singh by withdrawing a sum of Rs.9,00,000/-.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that pronote was executed by the complainant in lieu of loan availed from the petitioner.

Learned State counsel submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation; nothing is to be recovered from him and he is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case. Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 04.09.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
