The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 60 dated 20.03.2018, registered under Sections 307, 452, 427, 148 and 149 of the IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act at Police Station Sadar Amritsar, District Amritsar.

The operative part of the order dated 29.08.2018, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that on 05.07.2018, while granting interim bail to co-accused Harpreet Singh, following order has been passed in CRM-M-27540-2018: -

“Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner was not named in the FIR and he has been implicated in the case on the basis of the disclosure statement made by the co-accused namely Harmanjit Singh @ Harman and no motive is attributed towards the petitioner. Notice of motion for 10.09.2018.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner was not named in the FIR and his

name has been disclosed by the co-accused. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sarwan Singh, has not disputed the aforesaid factual position and submits that the petitioner be directed to join the investigation.

List again on 10.09.2018.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 29.08.2018, has already appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Sarwan Singh, has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation and the weapon has already been recovered and he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 29.08.2018, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
