In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for regular bail under the provision of Section 439 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.54 dated 20.04.2018 registered under Section 392 IPC and 25 of Arms Act (Later on charges were framed only under Section 395/399 IPC only and 392 IPC and 25 of Arms Act have been deleted) at Police Station Bhikhi District Mansa.

2. Petitioner is stated to have been arrested on 12.7.2018 for the offence under Sections 395 and 399 IPC. On 28.8.2018, learned State counsel submitted about the petitioner's antecedents that he is involved in three FIRs. Those FIRs are FIR No.12 of 2016 which is compromised and FIR was quashed,; FIR No.69 of 2012 wherein petitioner has been acquitted and FIR No.114 of 2016, matter is still pending consideration. Whereas in the present FIR challan has been filed and charges have been framed. Further matter is listed for evidence of prosecution witnesses.

3. In view of the above facts and circumstances so also the fact that trial of the case would take some more time to conclude, without commenting any opinion on the merit of case, petitioner-Sukhdeep Singh @ Vicky is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing requisite bail/surety bonds to the entire satisfaction of concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty

Magistrate.

5. Petitioner shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and he shall also not influence the witnesses or otherwise interfere with the fair trial.

6. Petition is allowed accordingly.
