The petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.69 dated 27.04.2013 registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Bhogpur, District Jalandhar.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that in pursuance to the order dated 29.09.2017, the petitioners have already appeared before the Investigating Officer and joined the investigation. It is further submitted that the matter has been compromised between the petitioners and the complainant.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from HC Kamaljit Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioners are not required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 29.09.2017 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
