This is a petition under section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of complaint on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-3) between the parties.

2. Pursuant to the order dated 25.07.2014, report dated 09.08.2017 of the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sri Muktsar Sahib, has been received. According to the said report, the statements of the parties have been recorded and the compromise is genuine and has been reached between the parties voluntarily out of their own free will and without any threat or coercion.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and complaint No.70 of 19.12.2012, under section 3(1)(x) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 and Section 323 IPC, alongwith all consequent proceedings having arisen therefrom, is hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
