RAMENDRA JAIN, J. (ORAL)

1. In the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. filed by the petitioners, prayer has been made for issuance of directions to official respondents to protect their life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.4 to 9.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners, at the very outset, contends that the purpose of the instant petition would be achieved, if respondent No.2-Senior Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar, is directed to decide representation/complaint dated 21.07.2018 (Annexure P-2), moved by the petitioners.
3. In view of the above, respondent No.2- Senior Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar, is directed to look into the matter and decide representation/complaint dated 21.07.2018 (Annexure P-2), moved by the petitioners, in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order and after affording an opportunity of hearing to them, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
4. In case, the petitioner is required for any interrogation by the police, one week's prior notice shall be issued to him under Section 160 Cr.P.C.
5. The instant petition stands disposed of accordingly.
