DAYA CHAUDHARY, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of order dated 20.08.2018, the petitioner has joined the investigation and this fact has been affirmed by learned State counsel, on instructions from Head Constable Balkar Singh but the bail to the petitioner has been opposed on the ground that eight more cases are pending against him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in two cases, the petitioner has been acquitted; in three cases, he had paid fine; in one case, the trial is going on but he is on bail and in one more case also, the petitioner is on bail. The present case is the eighth one.

Keeping in view the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and also the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation, the interim order dated 20.08.2018 passed in his favour is made absolute.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.

However, in case, the petitioner is found to be involved in any other case of similar nature, the State is at liberty to move an application for cancellation of his bail.
