The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in the event of arrest in FIR No. 28 dated 30.04.2017 under Sections 328, 323, 498-A of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station City Sanour whereby the petitioners have been summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C. by the trial Court to face trial.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioners have been summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C. to face trial and on the direction of this Court, have appeared before the trial Court and they have furnished bail bonds to its satisfaction and are facing trial. It is also contended that nothing is to be recovered from them.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, submits that petitioners have appeared before the trial Court .

In view of the facts that the petitioners have appeared before the trial Court, furnished the requisite bail bonds and are facing trial, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 18.08.2018 granting interim protection to the petitioners is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
