Affidavit of complainant Harpreet Kaur filed by her counsel is taken.

At the very onset, counsel for the complainant has made a statement that as per the instructions of complainant, he does not oppose the grant of bail and same is the stand of learned State counsel.

In the light of the same and the undisputed fact that the petitioner Manjit Singh and prosecutrix Harpreet Kaur are living together having undergone marriage with each other, it would be travesty of justice to send the petitioner behind the bars.

In the light of the statement made by the learned State counsel as well as counsel for the complainant, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 06.09.2018 is made absolute till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter,

petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

With these observations, the present petition stands disposed off.
