This is a petition under section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of DDR No.031, dated 22.08.2017 under sections 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC (sections 326, 325 IPC added later on) in FIR No.81, dated 20.08.2017, under sections 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC (sections 325, 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Sekhwan, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur.

2. Pursuant to the order dated 18.09.2017, report dated 15.12.2017 of J.M.IC., Batala, has been received in connected case i.e. **CRM-M-34280-2017** titled as **Bachittar Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others.** According to the said report, the statements of the parties have been recorded and the compromise is genuine and has been reached between the parties voluntarily out of their own free will and without any threat or coercion.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and DDR No.031, dated 22.08.2017 under sections 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC (sections 326, 325 IPC added later on) in FIR No.81, dated 20.08.2017, under sections 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC (sections 325, 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Sekhwan, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur, alongwith all consequent proceedings having arisen therefrom, is hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
