**HARI PAL VERMA, J. (ORAL)**

The petitioners have filed present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of a direction to official respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5, who are restraining the petitioners from running the Centre/State Lotteries agency.

Perusal of the paper book shows that earlier also, the petitioners had approached this Court for seeking similar relief by way of **CRM-M-17770 of 2018** titled as **Satbir Singh and others Versus State of Punjab and others** and vide order dated 30.04.2018, this Court had directed the Senior Superintendent of Police, Faridkot to examine the petitioners' representation and to pass a reasoned order. However, no such order has been placed on record.

Once this Court has already directed Senior Superintendent of Police, Faridkot (respondent No.3 herein) to look into the representation, filing of the present petition is nothing but a total abuse of process of law.

Accordingly, the present petition, being devoid of any merit, is dismissed.
