In this petition, petitioners have sought for regular bail in case FIR No.148 dated 17.07.2018 under Section 379-B IPC, Police Station Kosli, District Rewari.

2.) Perusal of the records, it is evident that there was serious altercation between the complainant and the petitioners in respect of certain issues. Arising out of the same, complainant has alleged that petitioners have snatched a sum of ₹ 2,000/-, mobile phone and motor-cycle from the complainant and companion.

3.) Learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned State counsel have not disputed that aforesaid snatched material has been recovered on the alleged date of incident.

4.) Heard.

5.) Since it is an isolated case relating to Section 379-B of the IPC against the petitioners, they are entitled to the benefit of regular bail in view of the fact that trial and other further proceedings would take its own time.

6.) In view of these facts and circumstances, petitioners are entitled to the benefit of regular bail; therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, present petition is allowed. Petitioners-Sandeep and Parveen are ordered to be released on bail on their furnishing bail/surety bonds to the entire satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned with the following conditions:-

(i) Petitioners shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and they shall not influence the witnesses or otherwise interfere with the fair trial.

(ii) Petitioners shall also appear before the Station House Officer concerned on last Saturday of every month at 10.00 a.m. and mark their presence.
