KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

This is a petition filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, for quashing of the FIR No. 72 dated 16.9.2015, registered under Sections 420/120-B of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Lakho Ke Behram, District Ferozepur (Annexure P-1) on the basis of compromise along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Report has been received from Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Guruharsahai that parties have effected compromise. Statements of both the parties i.e. complainant and the accused have been recorded against the FIR in question for the offences under Sections 420/120-B IPC.

Learned counsel for the parties contend that FIR is the outcome of a monetary dispute and the same has been resolved now.

Since the dispute has been amicably settled, therefore, FIR No. 72 dated 16.9.2015, registered under Sections 420/120-B of the Indian

Penal Code registered at Police Station Lakho Ke Behram, District Ferozepur (Annexure P-1) along with all consequential proceedings stands quashed.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
