The petitioners seek grant of regular bail in case registered vide FIR No.67 dated 22.06.2018 under Sections 18 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, Police Station Amloh, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

It is the case of prosecution that on 22.06.2018 when the police party was going towards village Salih, then two persons were seen moving on the road and who on seeing police party threw two packets which they were carrying and turned back. Said persons were apprehended on the basis of suspicion and each of the packets thrown by

the said young persons was recovered and each of the said two packets was found to contain 125 grams of Opium.

Notice of the petition was issued to the State.

Learned State counsel has informed that challan has already been filed in the present case.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the present case and also the fact that recovery in the present case is of intermediate quantity and that conclusion of trial is likely to take some time, in my opinion, no fruitful purpose would be served by further detaining the petitioners behind bars. Accordingly, petitioners- Sunil and Shreepal are ordered to be released on bail on their furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate Fatehgarh Sahib.

This petition stands accepted accordingly.
