ANITA CHAUDHRY, J

Petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.56 dated 04.06.2018, registered under Sections 363/366-A/379/120-B of IPC at P.S. Fattu DHINGA, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is the grandfather of the boy who has eloped with the complainant's daughter and the couple had approached the High Court seeking protection. Counsel refers to Annexure P-2. Counsel states that they are not in touch with their grandson and challan has been submitted as against the petitioner.

Learned State counsel informs that the girl could not be recovered and the father and mother of the boy are in custody and the boy has been declared a proclaimed offender.

Investigation is over *qua* the petitioner. Challan has been presented. No specific role has been attributed to the petitioner. Couple have themselves had approached the High Court for protection.

The trial would take time. Without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing surety and adequate bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
