This order will dispose of petition filed for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No. 135, dated 28.11.2017, registered under Section 379 B IPC read with Section 34 IPC, at P.S. Sujanpur, Pathankot.

Allegations against petitioner are that he snatched purse of complainant, which contained mobile phone and cash.

The learned State counsel has filed custody certificate in Court today and same is taken on record.

As per custody certificate, petitioner is in custody for last 1 year, 7 days (as on 14.12.2018). Trial of case is going on and three other cases are already lying registered against petitioner.

Considering custody, there is no justification for further detention of petitioner. Accordingly, petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing personal bond in the sum of Rs. 50,000/- with one surety of like amount to satisfaction of trial Court, subject

following conditions :-

1. Petitioner shall surrender his passport before trial Court, if any, and will not leave the country without permission of Court ;
2. Petitioner shall not directly or indirectly given any inducement or threat or promise to any witness ; and
3. Petitioner shall attend Court on each and every date of hearing before trial Court and in case of his absence, trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail.

Petition is allowed.
