The petitioner have filed present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to the respondents to take legal action against the accused in FIR No.206 dated 12.12.2014 under Section 302 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Makhu, District Ferozepur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has already made various representations i.e. Annexures P-5 to P-7 to the different authorities, but no action has been taken in the case.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Tanvir Joshi, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Heard.

Record reveals that after making the representation dated 24.08.2015 (Annexure P-7), no further representation has been made by the petitioner to the authorities for redressal of his grievances. Therefore, without making any observation on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the petitioner submits a fresh representation to respondent No.2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur within a period of 15 days from today, the said authority shall look into the contents of such representation and shall act in accordance with law.
