GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J.(Oral)

By way of filing this petition, the petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.0167 dated 28.7.2018 registered under Sections 365, 379-B, 341, 342, 506, 148 and 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Samrala, District Khanna and all consequential proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 18.8.2018, the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Samrala has been received, wherein it has been reported that the statements of petitioners/accused Gurpreet Singh @ Gopi, Sanam @ Sanampreet Singh, Dilpreet Singh @ Joga, Gurdeep Singh @ Deepa and Narinder Singh @ Lucky as well as of complainant Kulwinder Singh have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves and that

they have no objection in case the FIR in question is quashed. It has specifically been opined by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Samrala that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily and without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No.0167 dated 28.7.2018 registered under Sections 365, 379-B, 341, 342, 506, 148 and 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Samrala, District Khanna and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
