This is a petition for regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. on behalf of the petitioner, who was arrested on 04.07.2017 in case FIR No.135 dated 04.07.2017, under Sections 21/61/85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (in short 'NDPS Act') registered at Police Station Ambala Sadar, District Ambala.

[2]. The contraband allegedly recovered from the petitioner was below the commercial quantity. Although, charges have been framed in the Trial Court, but the prosecution evidence is yet to start, and even the Chemical Analysis Report is stated to be not yet available.

[3]. Earlier the petitioner was convicted under Section 21 of the NDPS Act in FIR No.408 dated 16.09.2012, but his sentence is stated to be under suspension, while he is on bail in another FIR bearing No.23/2013.

[4]. In the overall facts and circumstances, considering the long detention undergone by the petitioner, he is ordered to be released on

regular bail at this stage subject to the condition that he shall report at the concerned Police Station twice a week throughout the pendency of the Trial to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
