This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in a case registered against the petitioner under Sections 323, 324, 326 IPC (Section 308 IPC cancelled later on) at Police Station Sadar, Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar, vide FIR No.253 dated 25.05.2017.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that challan has been presented and offence under section 308 IPC has been deleted. Petitioner is in custody since 8.6.2017. Thus, no useful purpose will be served by detaining the petitioner in custody any longer.

On a query being put to the State counsel about the antecedents of the petitioner, he (on instructions from H.C. Vijay Pal, who is present in court) submits that petitioner is not involved in any other case.

Heard. Keeping in view the aforesaid contentions, period of incarceration of the petitioner, I am of the considered view that no useful purpose will be served by detaining the petitioner in custody any longer. The trial may take long time to conclude. Thus, without expressing any
