Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to respondent Nos. 1 and 2 for conducting fair and impartial inquiry in case FIR No. 236 dated 01.05.2018, registered under Sections 307, 34, 386 and 506 of the IPC at Police Station Sonipat Sadar, District Sonipat and also for not harassing the petitioner and to take legal action against respondent No. 4.

Reply, by way of affidavit of DSP, Sonipat, on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 to 3, has been filed in Court today. As per reply, after completion of investigation, report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has already been submitted against Amit @ Mita, Ajay @ Lovely and Kamlesh and three other persons, namely Sunny, Parveen and Pankaj, stand arrested and the challan against them shall be presented shortly. It is further stated in the reply that son of the petitioner, namely Parveen, is a habitual offender and he is involved in number of FIRs as detailed in para No. iv of the preliminary submission of the reply and since he was absconding from the

process of law, the police was making efforts to arrest him.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Naresh Kumar, submits that even the petitioner was arrested and later on she was released on regular bail and the case is now pending before the Illaqua Magistrate.

In view of the above, this petition is disposed of as infructuous.

However, liberty is granted to petitioner to approach the trial Court/Illaqua Magistrate for redressal of her grievance in accordance with law.
