In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for issuance of appropriate directions to the respondents to submit the final report under

Section 173 Cr.P.C. in FIR No. 179 dated 26.10.2016 registered at Police Station Sadar, Ludhiana under Sections 177, 193, 196, 465, 467, 468, 471, 420 and 120-B IPC.

2. Learned State counsel on instructions of ASI Pritam Pal, submitted that on 15.10.2018 challan has been filed. Out of 6 accused persons 2 have been arrested and non-bailable warrants have been issued against remaining 4 accused. Having regard to the prayer in the present petition and later development the present petition do not survive for consideration. Accordingly, petition stands disposed of as it has become infructuous.

3. Official respondent is hereby directed to apprise this court relating to action taken against 4 accused persons who are facing non-bailable warrants after 3 months.
