This is an application for advancing the date of hearing of the main case i.e. **CRM-M-35633-2018** from 19.09.2018 to today and the main case is taken on Board today itself.

CRM-M-35633-2018

The petition has been filed for issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner from respondents No.3 and 4 and further direction to respondent No.3, not to harass the petitioner as there is no case pending against him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that brother of the petitioner was an accused in FIR under section 302 IPC. The complaintant of the case tried to involve the petitioner also and moved an application under section 319 Cr.P.C. and

the same was rejected. The brother of the petitioner has been convicted and his appeal is pending in this Court. However, respondent No.4 is moving application against the petitioner to forcibly implicate him due to which respondent No.3 is harassing the petitioner. Despite representation dated 10.08.2018 (Anneuxre P-5), no action has been taken by the official respondents.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Kirat Singh Sidhu, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2 only. Let three copies of the complete paperbook be supplied to him during the course of the day. Considering the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to issue notice to respondent No.3 and 4..

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to objectively consider the representation dated 10.08.2018 (Anneuxre P-5) and to take appropriate action in accordance with law thereupon within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
