Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.208 dated 19.04.2018, registered at Police Station Sadar Ballabgarh, District Faridabad, under Sections 323, 325, 379-B, 506, 120-B and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared on behalf of respondent-State and complainant has also appeared through his counsel. They contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

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From the record, I find that as per the FIR, no injury has been attributed to the present petitioner. The allegation is only qua conspiracy/connivance with other accused. As per the allegations, some files have been snatched away from the complainant by two other persons at the instance of the present petitioner and one other co-accused.

The petitioner has been in custody since 16.06.2018. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping him in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
