This is a petition under Section 407 Cr.P.C. read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. for transfer of the Protest Petition No.119 of 2018, under Sections 354 and 506 IPC titled “Ranjeeta Versus Mukesh Kumar” from the Court of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ambala to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Karnal. The reason given in the petition seeking transfer is that since the petitioner is residing at Karnal, it is difficult for her to go to Ambala to attend the dates of hearing.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner besides going through the record.

Of course, the protest petition is to be filed in the Court, where cancellation report has been filed by the police. The personal appearance of the complainant in the Court on each and every date of hearing is not necessary. The distance between Karnal and Ambala is not that much, which could be taken to be difficult for the

petitioner to travel. In case the petitioner apprehends any risk or danger at the hands of the opposite party, she can bring this fact to the notice of Court concerned or Superintendent of Police of the District so as to get necessary action initiated in the matter. However, under the circumstances, there is no ground to accept the petition.

The petition is, therefore, dismissed.
