This is a petition that has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure praying for appropriate direction to the respondents to expedite the proceedings in case of execution proceedings.

Learned counsel for the petitioners herein submits under the proceedings under Section 125 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, respondent No.2 was directed to pay ₹5,000/- to the petitioners. However, not a single penny has been paid as on date even in the execution proceedings.

This Court had called for status report as to why conditional warrants were not being executed. Status report has been filed. The same is taken on record. As per report, respondent No.2 is permanent resident of the address given in the petition itself. The statement of the father of respondent No.2 was recorded. He stated his son is out of home for the last 4-5 months

and he does not know about his whereabouts.

In view of the report so received, no further orders are called for at the present moment. However, in case the petitioners move an application for attachment of any property of respondent No.2, the same shall be decided expeditiously, preferably within a period of one month from filing of such application.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
