In the instant petition, petitioners have sought for anticipatory bail under the provision of Section 438 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.250 dated 13.07.2018 registered under Sections 323, 34, 379-B, 452 and 506 IPC (Section 379-B deleted lateron) at Police Station Badhra, District Charkhi Dadri.

2. Pursuant to the query put vide order dated 20.08.2018 relating to whether injuries caused on the complainant-Mukesh, as stated in the FIR, are grievous in nature or not, learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Pawan Kumar submitted that injuries are simple in nature.

3. In view of these facts and circumstances, petitioners are directed to join the investigation as and when called by the Investigating Officer. In the event of their arrest, they shall be released on pre-arrest anticipatory bail by the Investigating Officer on their furnishing bail bonds/sureties to his satisfaction subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

4. Petition is allowed accordingly.
