While issuing notice of motion on 20.08.2018, the injury attributed to petitioner No.1-Vijay Sangwan was stated to be declared simple whereas as per opinion of the doctor, the injury is on the head and the same has been declared grievous.

No ground is made out to grant anticipatory bail to petitioner No.1-Vijay Sangwan.

The petition qua petitioner No.1-Vijay Sangwan is dismissed.

As far as case of petitioner No.2-Anju Sangwan is concerned, she has joined investigation and the same has been affirmed by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Pawan.

Keeping in view the role attributed to petitioner No.2 and the fact that she has joined investigation, interim order dated 20.08.2018 passed by this Court in favour of petitioner No.2-Anju Sangwan is made absolute.

The petition stands disposed of.
