This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C praying for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in Complaint No.92 dated 5.10.2015 titled as Gurmeet Singh Vs. Baldev Singh & others filed under sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 I.P.C and section 3(x) of Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act pending in the court of J.M.I.C, Sri Muktsar Sahib.

While issuing notice of motion the following order was passed by this Court on 18.9.2017:-

“Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that this Court has passed order dated 7.9.2017 in CRM-M-31343-2017 thereby granting anticipatory bail to the co-accused of the petitioner in the impugned criminal complaint.

Notice of motion to the respondent-State returnable on 7.11.2017. The complainant be also served.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the trial court and furnish bail bonds to its satisfaction upon which he will be admitted to interim bail in Complaint No.92 dated 5.10.2015 titled “Gurmeet Singh v/s Baldev Singh and others” under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468,

471, of Indian Penal Code, 1860, and Section 3(x) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989.”

Counsel makes a statement at the bar that in pursuance to the order dated 18.9.2017 passed by this Court, petitioner has duly put in appearance before the Trial Court on 27.9.2017 and has been admitted to interim bail upon furnishing personal bonds/surety bonds in the sum of Rs.10,000/- each.

It has also gone uncontroverted that co-accused Balwinder Singh has been granted concession of anticipatory bail by this Court.

Petitioner having joined trial proceedings, the present petition is allowed. The order dated 18.9.2017, passed by this Court, is made absolute.

Petition disposed of.
