The petitioners allege that they are being harassed by the police in collusion with the private respondents because the daughter of respondents No. 4 and 5 has eloped with the son of petitioners No. 1 and 2. Despite representation dated 14.08.2018 (Annexure P-1), their grievance has not been redressed.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3 only.

Mr. J.S. Walia, Sr. DAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3. Let four copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

Considering the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to issue notices to respondents No. 4 to 6.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No. 2 to objectively consider the representation dated 14.08.2018 (Annexure P-1) and to take appropriate action thereupon in accordance with law, in case it is so felt necessary, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
