The instant writ petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking a direction for the representation dated 15.05.2018 (Annexure P-2) in pursuance to the FIR No. 152 dated 16.12.2016 registered under Section 498-A, 406 IPC at police station Ajnala, District Amritsar, to be decided expeditiously.

It is contended that no legal proceedings have been initiated against respondents No. 4 to 8, who are the main persons involved. Learned counsel for the petitioners urges that the representation should be decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

At this stage, on the asking of the court Ms. Seena Mand, DAG Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and submits that

official respondents will look into the matter and will decide the representation of the petitioners within a period of six weeks, on receipt of certified copy of this order. Let sufficient number of copies of the paper book be supplied to her during the course of the day, failing which no action is called for.

In view of the above, I dispose of the instant petition by directing the official respondents to decide the representation dated 15.05.2018 (Annexure P-2) of the petitioners within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.

The petition stands disposed of in the above-said terms.
