The petitioner has filed present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to official respondents No.3 and 4 to decide the representation of the petitioner dated 11.04.2018 (Annexure P-4) and to take appropriate action against respondents No.6 to 8.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that as per General Diary Report dated 26.02.2018, Satpal succumbed to the injuries received in the accident while he was being taken to the hospital, where the doctor declared him dead. The petitioner himself has stated that the accident had taken place due to slipping of the motorcycle of Satpal in which he received injuries on his forehead and the accident was natural and by chance.

She further states that later on, it came to the notice that there was no damage on the motorcycle on which Satpal was riding at the time of accident. In order to have fair investigation in the matter, the petitioner

submitted a representation dated 11.04.2018 (Annexure P-4) to respondent No.3 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Rana Harjasdeep Singh, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Heard.

Without making any observation on the facts as projected by the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to look into the contents of representation (Annexure P-4) and to issue necessary directions for a fair inquiry in accordance with law. It is made clear that because the respondent No.3 has been directed to look into the representation, it shall not influence the respondent in any manner.
