Petitioners had prayed for grant of protection of their life and liberty and as they have solemnized marriage against the wishes of respondents No.4 and 5.

On 20.8.2018, following order was passed :-

“Petitioner No.1 is stated to be 17 years and 8 months of age, as such, is minor.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners are not seeking validity of their marriage and are ready to face all the legal consequences regarding this marriage. He has limited his prayer only for protecting the life and liberty of the petitioners.

Notice of motion for 26.10.2018.

In the meanwhile, respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Jind is directed to look into the submission of counsel for the petitioners regarding threat to the life and liberty of petitioners and take appropriate action in accordance with law.

However, it is made clear that the above order will not be interpreted as providing protection to the petitioners from legal action taken in any civil, criminal or other proceedings initiated/pending against them.”

In response to the notice of motion, reply on behalf of State by way of affidavit of Adarsh Deep Singh, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Detective Jind, has been filed, which contains Annexure R-2 i.e. the report of the Station House Officer, Police Station Julana, dated 16.10.2018. As per this report, petitioner Nisha Hooda has suffered statement that the couple does not face any threat as on today as the families have compromised the matter.

In view of the above, nothing survives for adjudication.

Therefore, the petition is disposed off as having become infructuous.
