2. The petitioner was earlier granted interim protection on
11.10.2017 as Chemical Analysis Report in respect of the contraband was not
available.

3. The same has since been received and goes against the petitioner.

4. Recovery allegedly effected in the present case is of commercial
quantity. Considering the history of the petitioner's involvement in other cases

under the NDPS Act although for small quantities, this is no longer a fit case to grant the benefit of bail to the petitioner.

5. As such the bail granted to him earlier is recalled. He is, however, permitted to surrender before the Ld. Trial Court within a week from date.
