This is a petition for regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. on behalf of the petitioner, who was arrested on 13.06.2017 in case FIR No.173 dated 13.06.2017, under Sections 22/65/85 of the Narcotics Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (in short 'NDPS Act') registered at Police Station Samrala, District Khanna.

[2]. Ld. State counsel submits that the Chemical Analysis Report has since been received. Two out of three articles recovered from the petitioner are outside the ambit of the NDPS Act. The third item, namely, Diphenoxylate and Atropine in the form of Lomotil tablets is admittedly below the commercial quantity. There is also no record of the petitioner's involvement in any other case under the NDPS Act.

[3]. Considering the long detention undergone by the petitioner, he is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to appropriate terms and

conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
