In the instant petition, petitioners have sought for quashing of FIR No.16 dated 26.02.2017 registered under Section 420 IPC at Police Station Sadar Moga, District Moga, on the basis of compromise.

2. Parties have entered into a compromise. This Court by order dated 06.02.2018 directed the parties to appear before the trial court/Illaq Magistrate for recording their statements with regard to veracity of compromise. It has been recorded by the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Moga, on 19.02.2018 and a report in this regard has been sent to this Court vide letter dated 12.03.2018 in which she clarify that compromise is voluntary with the consent and without coercion, undue influence or fear.

3. In view of the law laid down in **Narinder Singh** v. **State of Punjab**; 2014 (6) SCC 466, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.16 dated 26.02.2017 registered under Section 420 IPC at Police Station Sadar Moga, District Moga, alongwith all consequential proceeding arising out of this FIR are hereby quashed subject to litigation cost of Rs.2000/- to

be paid by each of the petitioner to the Home Department of State of Punjab.
