Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made to set aside the impugned order dated 26.10.2002 (Annexure P-1) passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, SBS Nagar, whereby the petitioner has wrongly been declared proclaimed offender.

Heard.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, present petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to appear before the trial Court within one month and shall be released on bail, subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

However, this order shall not be an embargo for the trial Court to conduct proceedings against the petitioner, in case, his plea that he was never effectively served before declaring him proclaimed offender as he had already left India is found false.
